Anti-Bully Campaign™ is a Cincinnati based partnership. Our mission is to help schools protect all students by eliminating student bullying and harassment. While bullying behavior has always existed, the nature of the behavior has changed. With the advent of access to the internet, texting, instant messaging and face book, these behaviors are targeted, accelerated, and intensified. These strategies have proved very effective in stopping bullies and creating an atmosphere where all children feel safe. Our goal is also to assist schools in conforming with state law requirements, understanding the state model policy, and to protect school and employee liability.
